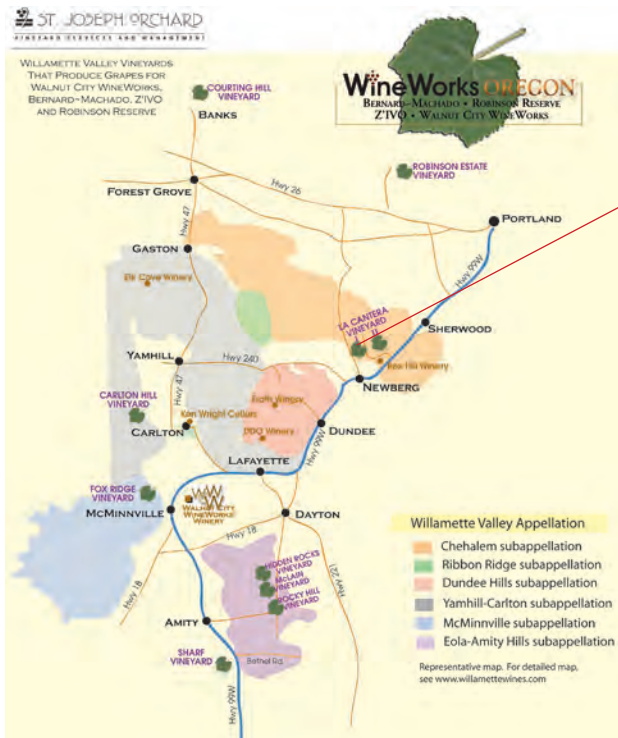




2000 Pinot Noir

Cardamom-cinnamon spice with dried cherry. A strong well-integrated mid-palate of cherry, pomegranate and spice. Delicate structure and balanced acidity.

“Old World” and Burgundian in scope, La Cantera Pinot Noir is also an homage to the winemaker’s family heritage in the early history of California winemaking.

In the Laurelwood soils of the Chehalem Mountains in the Willamette Valley overlooking Newberg, La Cantera Vineyard’s own-rooted 20-year-old Pommard and Wädenswil clones of Pinot Noir are the essence of each vintage of Bernard~Machado La Cantera Vineyard Pinot Noir.
