



## 2004 Cabernet Sauvignon

Cedar/spice and ultraripe black fruit aromas lead to chocolate and herb-jammy cassis with great structure. Look to a finish with spicy, black cherry, and tobacco highlights.



### Vineyard Notes

Del Rio Vineyard—the largest planting in the Rogue Valley of Southern Oregon—enjoys a wonderful climate located along the 42nd parallel and at an altitude of approximately 1,000 feet. The rocky south-facing slopes of the vineyard drain well and provide excellent terrain for producing premium wine grapes. Over 200,000 vines produce a diverse selection of grape varieties.
