

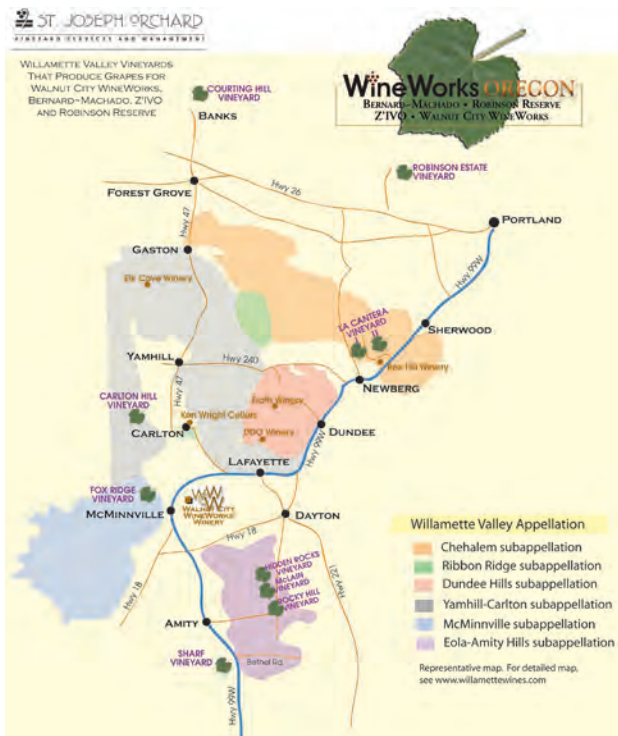

2006 Pinot Noir WILLAMETTE VALLEY

Brilliant red color. Buttery nose with spice, earth, and cinnamon highlights. Mouth is bright red, black cherry with light raspberry, strawberry, cinnamon, and earth, with long cherry berry finish. Will continue to develop and improve for 4–7 years. Like the WCWW 06 Pinot Reserve, this wine harkens to classic Willamette Valley pinots before Robert Parker.
